Bayside Bears Flag/Tackle Football Coaches Contract

Our goal is to provide an environment where children will have fun and develop the values of sportsmanship, teamwork, commitment and hard work. We encourage scholastic achievement and family involvement while acting as consistent and caring role models.

- All coaches must be approved by the President in advance, absolutely no exceptions.
- All head coaches must attend the BCYFCA must attend all BCYFCA coaching clinics or meetings.
- All head coaches must attend all Bayside Bears coaches training and meetings as scheduled by the Tackle Director.
- All coaches must be NYSCA certified.
- All tackle coaches must have a copy of the BCYFCA Tackle Rules; Flag Coaches must have a copy of the BCYFCA Flag Rules. The BCYFCA rules supersede BBYFCA rules. FOLLOW THEM!
- Make sure your "Roster Book" is in your possession at all practices and games and that you have roster sheets at each game.
- As a Bayside Bear Coach, you are required to attend all pep rallies, fundraisers, dances, etc. You will be expected to volunteer on game day and to support ALL Bayside Bear teams.
- Be organized and plan your practices.
- Do not touch a player when you're angry. Never touch a player in any private area.
- Do not use any abusive or foul language.
- Do not wear any clothing that promotes firearms, alcohol, tobacco products or bars.
- No arguing with officials or opposing coaches. Only the Head Coach is to talk to officials.
- No parents on the sidelines except coaches; control the crowd.
- Parent/guardian or coach complaints must be submitted in writing to the President or any Board Member.
- Report any rules violations to the President or any Board Member present.
- Give your kids plenty of water breaks; take no chances with heat exhaustion.
- Take no chances with health issues. If necessary, call parent, evacuate or call for ambulance. Keep all asthma inhalers in one location.
- Encourage sportsmanship and teamwork.
- Safety is our first concern; medical kits will be issued to each team. Have them at all times!
- All players will play a minimum of 4 plays. Any violation of this rule will result in suspension and or permanent expulsion.
- No Bayside Bear team is allowed to score 50 points unless the other team is within 3 touchdowns. Be pro-active; don't put yourself in a position to go over 50.
- Do not blitz, run outside, pass, have star players handle the ball or run trick plays when up by 4 touchdowns or more, except for first series after half. If it's late in the game-run the clock out.
- If a player quits or throws his helmet/shoulder pads in anger, player is expelled from the program, collect his equipment from him on the spot.
